NEW “JI” CODE FOR JURONG ISLAND

Jurong Island was formed in the late 1990s as a result of reclamation of seven islands located off the western tip of Singapore. The road linking the island to the mainland was officially launched on 10 Feb 2000. To transform the island into a world-class chemical manufacturing centre and an integrated Chemical Logistics Hub, the Island has been gazetted as an authorised place for the import, export and transhipment of petroleum and petrochemical products.

2 Henceforth, the following island codes which are currently used as places of receipt or release in your declarations will cease:

<u>Island</u>	<u>Codes in current use</u>
Pulau Ayer Chawan	PACA, PACB, PACC, PACE
Pulau Ayer Merbau	PAM
Pulau Merlimau	PM
Pulau Pesek	PP
Pulau Pesek Kecil	PP
Pulau Sakra	PSK
Pulau Seraya	PSRB

In place of the above codes, you will now declare the place of receipt or release as “**JI**” for Jurong Island.

3 This change will take effect from 13 Jan 2001.
