

Lifting of Prohibition on Exports to Eritrea and Ethiopia

I&E Notice No. 5/2001

To: All Traders, Freight Forwarders,
Cargo Agents and Carriers

Further to our I&E Notice No. 7/2000 dated 9 Oct 2000, we wish to inform you that the prohibition of the following exports to Eritrea and Ethiopia from Singapore is lifted with immediate effect:

- a. arms and related materials of all types, including
 - i) weapons
 - ii) ammunition
 - iii) military vehicles and equipment
 - iv) paramilitary equipment; and

- b. spare parts for the items listed in (a).

TradeNet Users

If you are a TradeNet user and you have updated your front-end software to include the following message earlier where the country of destination is Eritrea (ER) or Ethiopia (ET), please remember to delete it:
