FEE REVISION



In our continuing efforts to facilitate trade and reduce business costs for traders, CED has reviewed the charging methodology for our customs fees. With effect from 1 Sep 2002, the time-based fees payable on the following Customs services will be charged on a per 30-minute block instead of per hourly block. The revised fees are as follows:

1. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with – (a) Survey of goods (b) Destruction of goods (c) Survey and destruction of goods	(a) \$20) per half hour (b) \$40) or part thereof (c) \$40) per continuous) operation
2. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with - (a) the stuffing and unstuffing of containers (b) the bottling, blending, compounding, varying or denaturing of intoxicating liquors in a licensed warehouse (c) the reconditioning of liquors and tobacco in bond at the request of the owner or his agent (d) the packing and, if necessary, the sealing of cases and packages of duty-paid goods for re-export under drawback (e) operations in premises not licensed under the Act (f) such other act or service requiring the attendance of officers of customs as the Director-General may determine	\$20 per half hour or part thereof per continuous operation
3. Escort of vehicles, containers or craft conveying dutiable or other goods as the Director-General may determine	\$20 per half hour or part thereof per continuous operation
