## REMINDER ON DECLARATION PROCEDURES FOR STRATEGIC GOODS PERMIT APPLICATIONS

We wish to remind all traders on the declaration procedures for strategic goods permit applications submitted via the TradeNet<sup>®</sup> 4.0.

### Declaration Procedure for Product Code

2 Traders and declaring agents need to declare the following:

- (a) For goods/technology listed in Division 2 – List of Military Goods of Part I of the Schedule of the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2010, **all Category Codes as reflected on the list should be declared as Product Codes for strategic goods permit applications**, i.e. Category Codes are equivalent to Product Codes for goods/technology under the Munitions List.

#### Example 1

*For an item which falls under Category Code ML1, the Product Code to be declared on strategic goods permit applications will be ML1.*

- (b) For goods/technology listed in Division 2 – List of Dual-Use Goods of Part II of the Schedule of the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2010, **a prefix, “DL”, followed by the corresponding 5-digit Category Code on the list**, should be declared as the Product Code in strategic goods permit applications.

#### Example 2

*For an item which falls under Category Code 0A001, the Product Code to be declared on strategic goods permit applications will be DLOA001.*

### Additional Declaration Procedure

3 Please key in the Product Code in the CA/SC Product Code Field and fill up all the following additional mandatory fields for strategic goods permit applications submitted via the TradeNet<sup>®</sup> 4.0:

- (a) The consignee name and address
- (b) The end-user name and address
- (c) The end-use:
  - (i) Code (1) whether it is meant for military (MIL) or non-military (NMU) purposes

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by assuring the integrity of the trading system*

- (ii) Code (2) whether it is meant for government (GOV) or non-government (NGU) purposes
- (iii) Code (3) whether it is for weapons of mass destruction (WMD) or non-WMD (NMD) purposes

### **Supporting Documents Required**

4 The following supporting documents are required when you submit the strategic goods permits:

- (a) End-User Certificate (EUC);
- (b) Export Licences, and their corresponding translation in English, from the supplying country (if applicable);
- (c) Import Authorisation (IA) from the country of import (for Munitions List and WMD related items);
- (d) Technical Specifications of the goods, e.g. operating instructions, manuals, brochures, data sheets, etc.;
- (e) End-user company profile and/or website; and
- (f) Other relevant supporting documents.
