SUSPENSION OF FRESH AND PROCESSED FRUITS AND VEGETABLES FROM HYOGO PREFECTURE

Please refer to our circular dated 1 April 2011.

Following the latest detection of radioactive contaminants in a sample of cabbage imported from the Hyogo prefecture, the Agri-Food & Veterinary Authority of Singapore (AVA) will extend its suspension of import of fruits and vegetables from Hyogo with immediate effect.

The status of our suspension of food imports from Japan as at 05 April 2011 is as follows:

Source	Item
Fukushima, Ibaraki, Tochigi and Gunma	Milk, milk products, seafood, meat, fruits and vegetables (fresh & processed) & seaweed
Hyogo, Shizuoka, Ehime, Chiba, Kanagawa, Tokyo and Saitama	Fruits and vegetables (fresh & processed)

Please ensure that the prefecture of origin of all imports from other parts of Japan is clearly stated (beside the product description) in the import declaration for the products.

AVA inspectors will be contacting you to collect samples for testing purpose. You may also contact our inspectors at the following numbers to arrange for inspection too.
