Importers of Feed for Non-Food Producing Animals

(All declaring agents are requested to inform your consignees or importers of the contents of this circular)

PROHIBITION ON IMPORT OF ANIMAL FEED CONTAINING CANNABIS AND ITS DERIVATIVES FOR NON-FOOD PRODUCING ANIMALS

In Singapore, cannabis (referring to any part of a plant of the genus Cannabis) and its derivatives are listed as Class 'A' controlled drugs under the First Schedule of the Misuse of Drug Act (MDA) and the import, trafficking, possession and consumption of cannabis and cannabis products are offences under the MDA.

2 In view of this, the import and sale of feed containing cannabis and its derivatives (e.g. oil, protein, seed) in Singapore for non-food producing animals is not allowed.
