BUSINESS OPERATIONS BEYOND LICENSING HOURS

Currently, all licensed premises, with the exception of Changi Airport Transit Restaurant Bar and the Airport duty-free shop, must remain closed during their stipulated closing hours. During the hours when the licensed premises are required to be closed, no licensee shall permit any person, other than his employee or an occupier of the licensed premises, to remain in the premises.

2 We are pleased to inform you that with effect from 15 Dec 99, the stipulated closing hours would only relate to sale and consumption of liquors in the licensed premises. Licensees are permitted to have their premises remain open beyond the stipulated closing hours for business activities other than for sale and consumption of liquors in the premises. Please note that during the stipulated closing hours for sale and consumption of liquors, no person shall at any licensed premises:

- a sell or offer for sale any intoxicating liquor;
- b keep open the licensed premises to sell intoxicating liquor; or
- c allow the consumption of intoxicating liquors in the licensed premises.
