All Bonded Warehouse Operators

**OPERATIONS IN A BONDED WAREHOUSE**

Bonded areas of warehouses are currently demarcated for storage of only GST suspended goods while all other goods which have been GST paid must be kept outside of this demarcated bonded warehouse area. To facilitate warehousing operations and optimisation of warehouse space, bonded warehouse operators are given the flexibility to increase or decrease their bonded warehouse areas provided that Customs are keep posted in writing of the changes to the bonded areas.

2 In addition, to facilitate releases of goods from bonded warehouses under ME Permits, Outward Permits and Removal Permits, traders need only to declare one permit type per client to cover multiple releases to be made within the same day. The permit can then be amended at the end of the day to reflect the actual total quantity of the goods released during the whole day.
