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CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT

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All Traders, Licensed Warehouse and Bonded Warehouse Operators

FEE REVISION

With effect from 1 Jun 99, the fees payable on the following Customs licences/services will be revised. The revised fees are as follows:

(A) LICENCES

Type of Licence	Fee payable per annum
1. Licence to warehouse (a) intoxicating liquors and tobacco (b) all other dutiable goods, except petroleum	\$10,000 \$10,000
2. Licence to distil, ferment or manufacture any other intoxicating liquors	\$28,000
3. Licence to manufacture tobacco	\$120,000
4. Licence to refine and treat petroleum	\$60,000
5. Licence to warehouse, mix blend or otherwise vary petroleum	\$30,000
6. Licence to operate a duty-free shop for tourists	\$70,000
7. Transfer of a Liquor Licence	\$14 per transfer

(B) SERVICES

Type of Services	New Rate
1. Certification of landing certificates, true copies of customs permits and any other documents as the Director-General may determine	\$15 per document
2. Copies of statements supplied to defence counsel	\$45 per document

3. Approval of a certificate of exemption where the customs duty on industrial raw materials exceeds \$100	\$225
4. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with – (a) survey of goods (b) destruction of goods (c) survey and destruction of goods	\$30) per hour or part \$62) thereof per conti \$62) –nuous operation
5. Attendance of an officer of customs in connection with - (a) the stuffing and unstuffing of containers (b) the bottling, blending, compounding, varying or denaturing of intoxicating liquors in a licensed warehouse (c) the reconditioning of liquors and tobacco in bond at the request of the owner or his agent (d) the packing and, if necessary, the sealing of cases and packages of duty-paid goods for re-export under drawback (e) operations in premises not licensed under the Act (f) such other act or service requiring the attendance of officers of customs as the Director-General may determine	\$30 per hour or part thereof per continuous operation
6. Escort of vehicles, containers or craft conveying dutiable or other goods as the Director-General may determine	\$38 per hour or part thereof per continuous operation
7. Attending to enquiries relating to the classification of any goods for the purposes of the Act	\$80 per item of goods in respect of which enquiry is made
8. Attendance of an officer of customs in connection with - (a) the extension of opening hours in respect of customs offices, licensed factory warehouses, licensed warehouses, bottling warehouses, licensed distilleries, breweries, tobacco factories and other licensed factories for the manufacture of dutiable goods and container freight stations; or (b) the stuffing, unstuffing or any operation at any place beyond the hours specified	Additional \$30 per hour or part thereof per continuous operation
