**AMENDMENT TO THE C6 CONDITION CODE**

Our existing procedure stipulates that payment permits with C6 condition imposed therein have to be returned with supporting documents to Head Documentation within 14 days after Customs clearance of the goods. We have received feedback from traders that considerable amount of effort has to be put in to track the clearance status of the goods for the returning of the permits and supporting documents to CED. We have therefore amended the C6 condition to streamline the procedure. With effect from 15 May 99, you will be able to return the permit and its supporting documents to us once it has been approved.

2 The amended C6 condition would read as follows :

<u>Condition Code</u>	<u>Description</u>
C6	You are required to mail a copy of this permit, invoices, freight and insurance papers to Head documentation at #10-01, 55 Newton Road, Revenue House, Singapore 307987 within 14 days from the date of approval of the permit.
