### COMMON QUESTIONS ON CUSTOMS DECLARATIONS/PROCEDURES: HELPLIST 10/2001

I am pleased to list below the questions and answers for List 10/2001:

- Q1 I have a consignment of local cargo that was delivered to Keppel Wharves (KZ) for export. Due to urgent request by my overseas client, I have to transport the consignment to Changi FTZ (CZ) instead for export by air. Do I need to take out a TradeNet permit for the transfer of the consignment from KZ to CZ?
- A1 In this instance, a Customs White Transshipment Permit "TW" is required for the movement of your consignment from Keppel Wharves to Changi FTZ. The declaration purpose should be "Z". The place of release and place of receipt would be "KZ" and "CZ" respectively.
- Q2 If the value of the goods is higher than the declared value in the ME permit, what shall I do?
- A2 If the goods have not been cleared, you may apply for amendment electronically through the TradeNet to the ME permit. However, if the goods have been cleared, you have to account to IRAS during your accounting return showing supporting documents for the actual value of the goods.
- Q3 I am importing two shipments of the same wine that will be arriving in Singapore one after another. Do I need to apply for liquor analysis for the two shipments?
- A3 If the wine comes in standard-size bottle packing and duty is payable based on the volumetric capacity, you need not apply for liquor analysis for the second shipment as the test results for the earlier shipment will be valid for imports of the same wine for the next three years.
