AUTO PROCESSING OF TRANSHIPMENT DECLARATIONS WITH LIQUOR AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS

Following an enhancement of our in-house system on 1 Feb 2001, traders can transmit their transshipment declarations of dutiable liquors and tobacco for electronic processing via the TradeNet system. With the new facility, traders can dispense with the faxing of supporting documents such as Bill of Lading/ Air WayBill, invoice and vessel/ flight booking confirmation to Customs.

2 However, the existing practice of furnishing a copy of the permit with the Master's acknowledgement to Permits and Manifests Section, Customs HQ or Air-cargo Section, Airports Branch within 4 working days after it has been used is to be continued. This requirement is stated as one of the conditions imposed in the approved Customs permit.
