All Traders and Declaring Agents

BONA-FIDE LIQUORS/TOBACCO TRADE SAMPLES IMPORTED BY AIR

Individuals or their agents presently declare a Customs duty payment permit for bona-fide trade samples/gifts/personal items of liquors/tobacco imported by air.

2 In order to reduce their documentation cost and simplify Customs procedures, no Customs permit is required, with immediate effect, if the quantity of such bona-fide trade samples/gifts/personal items imported by air does not exceed 10 litres for liquors and 1 kilogramme for tobacco. The individual or his agent could make payment for duty and GST at the Customs Checkpoint, Air Cargo Complex, Changi Airport. For agents (Air Cargo Agents or Air Express Companies) operating GIRO accounts with CED, payment could be made easier via Inter-bank GIRO.
