## AMENDMENTS TO THE STRATEGIC GOODS CONTROL LIST

In line with our international obligations to prevent the proliferation of weapons of mass destruction, Singapore Customs will need to continuously review and bring our control list up-to-date with international practices. In this regard, the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2007 will be rescinded and replaced with a new Order which would come into effect on 1 Apr 2009.

2 The Strategic Goods Control List in the new Order includes new entries to the existing categories, some deletions as well as editorial changes for consistency and clarity of controls. 3 Singapore Customs will also be conducting a series of awareness briefings to various industry clusters in Mar 2009 on these impending changes.
