CUSTOMS PROCEDURES ON INTERNET

Our first Customs procedures uploaded onto the INTERNET on 3 Oct 95 gave readers an overview of the documentary requirements and clearance procedures on the import, export and transshipment of goods in Singapore. Topics covered include Customs duty and Goods & Services Tax, Customs documentation, Customs valuation, Customs clearance, Customs procedures and other information.

2 We are pleased to let you know the following additional topics uploaded onto our home page on INTERNET since then:

- Guide to Travellers (Uploaded on 9 Feb 96)
Amongst the information provided in this section is the duty and GST allowances travellers and returning residents may enjoy on their entry or return to Singapore. The goods whose entry require a permit or licence and those goods which are prohibited from import are also listed in this section.
- Temporary Importation of Goods for Exhibitions (Uploaded on 2 May 96)
Under this section, the various schemes under which exhibition goods may be temporarily imported into Singapore for exhibition, the permit requirements and clearance procedures are given.
- GST Relief on Re-imported Goods (Uploaded on 2 May 96)
Here, the type of goods which qualify for GST relief, the conditions for approval, the permit and clearance procedures are explained in detail to assist companies wishing to know whether their goods qualify for relief.
- Transfer of Residence to Singapore (Uploaded on 2 May 96)
Foreign nationals transferring residence to Singapore and returning Singaporeans will be guided as to the items which may be imported without payment of GST and the documentary requirements for their clearance from the port.
