OUTREACH SEMINARS FOR SUPPLY CHAIN SECURITY

In July 2006, Singapore announced the implementation of a National Supply Chain Security Programme which has been named as the Secure Trade Partnership (STP).

2. The STP is a voluntary programme administered by Singapore Customs that encourages companies to adopt robust security practices and partner Singapore Customs to improve the security of the global supply chain.

3. The STP provides companies with a framework to guide the development, implementation, monitoring and review of the company's supply chain security measures. The STP also spells out a set of supply chain security guidelines which companies in the supply chain should achieve to enhance the security of their operations, and by which companies can obtain certification from Singapore Customs.

4. To create and raise companies' awareness on the importance of supply chain security and to promote the STP, Singapore Customs will be conducting several outreach seminars, at no charge, in the month of January 2007.
