FEE REVISION

With effect from 1 Apr 2000, the fees payable on the following Customs licences/services will be revised. The revised fees are as follows:

(A) LICENCES

Type of Licence	Fee payable per annum
1. Licence to warehouse, mix blend or otherwise vary petroleum	\$32,000
2. Licence to operate a bonded warehouse for - (a) crude oil; or (b) any petroleum product distilled or otherwise derived from crude oil, for which no duty (whether customs or excise duty or both customs duty and excise duty) is chargeable or payable	\$18,000

(B) SERVICES

Type of Services	New Rate
1. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with - (a) survey of goods (b) destruction of goods (c) survey and destruction of goods	\$35) per hour or part \$70) thereof per \$70) continuous) operation
2. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with - (a) the stuffing and unstuffing of containers (b) the bottling, blending, compounding, varying or denaturing of intoxicating liquors in a licensed warehouse (c) the reconditioning of liquors and tobacco in bond at the request of the owner or his agent (d) the packing and, if necessary, the sealing of cases and packages of duty-paid goods for re-export under drawback (e) operations in premises not licensed under the Act (f) such other act or service requiring the attendance of officers of customs as the Director-General may determine	\$35 per hour or part thereof per continuous operation

Type of Services	New Rate
3. Attendance of officers of customs in connection with - (a) the extension of opening hours in respect of customs offices, licensed factory warehouses, licensed warehouses, bottling warehouses, licensed distilleries, breweries, tobacco factories and other licensed factories for the manufacture of dutiable goods and container freight stations (b) the stuffing, unstuffing or any operation at any place beyond the hours specified	Additional \$35 per hour or part thereof per continuous operation

(C) WAREHOUSE RENT

Warehouse rent for goods deposited in Government warehouses situated within the boundary limits of an airport and in transit warehouses operated by the Director-General shall be charged warehouse rent for goods other than intoxicating liquors and tobacco deposited by bona fide travellers	\$0.30 per kg gross weight pro rata subject to a minimum of \$4.00
