With heightened terrorism threats and the growing danger posed by the increasing sophistication of weapons of mass destruction (WMD) proliferation activities, export control or strategic goods control is an area of growing importance to prevent the unauthorised trade or transfers of such goods and technology to undesirable parties. As part of the trading community, you play a vital role in ensuring that strategic goods do not land in the wrong hands.

The **Japan-Singapore-United States Export Controls Seminar** aims to enhance industries' awareness of the export control systems implemented in Japan, Singapore and the US. The Seminar also seeks to highlight the importance of internal compliance procedures and to share some of the industries' best practices.

As part of our continuous efforts to review and enhance our strategic goods control system, Singapore will be expanding the strategic goods control list for export, transshipment and transit. In line with the expanded controls, Singapore Customs will introduce a 3-tier **Strategic Trade Scheme (STS)** which is aimed to encourage self-compliance and to facilitate companies' legitimate trade in dual-use strategic goods and technology. Singapore Customs will be introducing the STS at this event.
