All Traders And Declaring Agents

PROHIBITION ON IMPORTS FROM IRAN UNDER UNSC RESOLUTION 1747 (2007)

We wish to inform you that in accordance with the UN Security Council Resolution 1747 (2007), the importation from Iran of the following items is prohibited under Regulation 6(2)(d) and the Seventh Schedule of the Regulation of Imports and Exports Regulation (Rg 1) with effect from 15 Jun 2007:

- (1) Arms or related material

Penalties

2 Any person who contravenes any of the prohibitions shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction –

- a) to a fine not exceeding \$100,000 or 3 times the value of the goods whichever is greater, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years or to both; and
- b) on the second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding \$200,000 or 4 times the value of goods, whichever is greater, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 years or both.
