**UNDERSTANDING THE NEW STRATEGIC GOODS CONTROL LIST & THE INTERNATIONAL EXPORT CONTROL REGIMES**

Do you know that Singapore Customs will expand our control list under the Strategic Goods (Control) Act come **1 Jan 2008**? Do you know if the goods you are trading or transferring, is subject to this control? Are you ready for it? If you do not already know, the new items will include goods that are commercially traded or transferred for commercial or civilian purposes.

2 If not, we would strongly encourage you to attend an **"Insight to Strategic Goods Control Under International Export Control Regimes Seminar"** on:

3 The seminar will give you an overview of the four international export control regimes viz. The Australia Group, the Missile Technology Control Regime, the Nuclear Suppliers Group and the Wassenaar Arrangement. This will be conducted by experts from the United States' Department of Energy (DOE).

4 More importantly, you will be briefed by Singapore Customs on the items that we are currently controlling and will be controlling for the export, transshipment, transit, and brokering, as well as intangible transfers or electronic transmission of the technology and software of the controlled strategic goods, as from 1 Jan 08.

5 The Seminar is intended for exporters, distributors, freight forwarders, cargo agents, carriers, brokers, and individuals handling strategic goods or transfers of related software and technology. It is ideal for all practitioners in export controls who want to supplement their understanding of strategic goods controlled under the

international export control regimes and if your trade/business or transfer will be subject to control under the Strategic Goods (Control) Act.

### **Seminar Fees**

6 The seminar fee is **S\$45** (inclusive of 7% GST) per participant. A certificate of attendance will be issued to each participant upon completion of the Seminar. Seminar materials and refreshments will be provided.

### **Payment mode**

8 For payment of seminar fee, you would need to provide us with an authorization to deduct the seminar fee from your company's Inter-Bank Giro (IBG) Account. If you do not have an IBG Account with Singapore Customs, you may issue a crossed cheque made payable to: **"Singapore Customs"** for the total seminar fee (if there are more than 1 participants from your company/organisation) at S\$45 (inclusive of 7% GST) per participant, before the closing date of registration.

9 We will confirm your registration via email/fax before the commencement of the Seminar. Confirmation will be given upon full payment of the seminar fee.
