IMPORTATION OF SHIP SPARES FOR REPAIR

Please note that the declaration form for the importation of ship spares for repair into Singapore has been revised. A copy of the form can be downloaded from this weblink: <http://www.customs.gov.sg/topNav/ese/Online+Services+and+Forms.htm>. This declaration form must be presented for cargo clearance at the checkpoints.

2 With further reference to our Circular No. 19/2000 issued on 3 June 2000, please note that payment advice will no longer be issued at the point of clearing ship spares at the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) checkpoints. Under the new arrangement, Singapore Customs (SC) head office will create the IBG deductions for the payment of GST on ship spares. The payment advice will be forwarded to you via automail.

3 If you are declaring the ship spares on your importer's behalf and your importer is paying the GST, please obtain authorization from your importer by completing the section entitled 'Authorisation for payment by IBG' in the declaration form.
