OUTREACH PROGRAMME ON SECURE TRADE PARTNERSHIP (STP)

The Secure Trade Partnership (STP), launched in May 07, is a voluntary programme that encourages companies to adopt robust security practices and partner Singapore Customs to improve the security of the global supply chain.

2. With effect from 1 Oct 08, companies can apply to Singapore Customs to be certified as “STP-Plus”, the new tier under the STP programme. To attain the “STP-Plus” status, companies have to meet the requirements under the new STP Criteria.

3. As part of our outreach efforts to enhance industry's awareness on supply chain security and the STP programme, Singapore Customs is organising a series of STP courses in 2009. The courses seek to develop companies' understanding of the requirements under the STP programme. Participants will also be provided with case studies, to enhance their understanding of the preparation for the STP application.

4. The STP courses are intended for players in the different nodes of the supply chain such as suppliers, manufacturers, warehouse operators and owners, transporters, terminal operators and sea and air freight operators.

5. The STP courses will be held at Singapore Customs, 55 Newton Road, Revenue House, #09-02, Singapore 307987. The courses are scheduled on the following dates:
