## LEVY OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES

Arising from the promulgation of the Final Order, the anti-dumping duties imposed on all imports of bars and rods of iron or non-alloy steel under HS Codes 7214.20 005 and 7214.50 008 originating in Turkey have been revised with immediate effect as follows:

2 Importers who had previously paid the interim duties which are higher than the above rates of duties may claim for refund on the difference between the interim and final duty rates. Applications for refund should be made in writing to the Director-General of Customs & Excise with the supporting copies of duty payment permits within six months from the date of this circular. If you need any assistance or further clarification on the application for refund, please contact Mr Koh Beng Heng or Mr Ong Choon Beng at telephone 3752141/2.

3 As for those importers who had already obtained their payment permits at the previous rates of duties, these permits could still be accepted for use at the entry point on and after 2 Dec 95. Refund of duty on the difference between the interim and final duty rates will still be granted on the same basis as that in paragraph two above.
