The types of Customs declarations that are currently processed on-line under TradeNet are listed in Annexes A & B attached.

**CUSTOMS PAYMENT DECLARATIONS THAT ARE PROCESSED ON-LINE UNDER TRADENET**

***Pure Customs Payment Declaration (DP)***

- a Payment type under "SP" (Short Payment).
- b Payment type under "TI" (Goods previously imported under Temporary Import permit).
- c Payment type under "GP" and the Place of Release is not from a Bonded Warehouse.
- d Payment type under "CD" (Conditional Duty payment for liquors) in which no prior approval was given by Customs.
- e Payment type under 'ND' (Normal Payment from Licensed Warehouse) in which the DSS analysis result is not yet registered with Customs.
- f Payment type under "DR" in which the petrol pump price declared is not the current pump price.
- g Payment declaration in which the field, "Unit SCOM", value is filled except for the payment of Customs duty on duty-exempted motor-vehicles.
- h For Customs Duty Payment declaration exceeding \$2,000/- duty in which no bank guarantee has been lodged.

**II     *Joint or Pure Customs Payment Declaration***

- a     Payment type under "DI" (Direct Import) in which the declarant did not apply for a waiver of DSS analysis for the duty payment of liquors.
  
- b     For all payment declarations in which the field "vehicle type" is declared as "U" (used).

- III    *IG Permits* -     For declarations where the Inward Carrier Agent is not registered with Customs.**

**CUSTOMS NON-PAYMENT DECLARATIONS THAT ARE PROCESSED ON-LINE UNDER TRADENET**

**a *Inward Declaration***

- temporary import (eg motor vehicles and other goods where there is insufficient BG)
- Re-importation (no customs outward permit declared)
- Liquor/Tobacco (exceeding 14 days of arrival)
- Discharge at private yards/wharves (non authorised landing place, prior approval from PSA and Customs is required before landing)
- Place of receipt Airports T1 and T2 (hand carried goods)

**b *Outward Declaration***

- Temporary import (declaring agent differs from inward permit)
- Loading at private yards/wharves
- Place of receipt (Airports T1 & T2)
- Sea stores (non-cargo/passenger vessels)

**c *White Transhipment Declaration***

- Liquor/Tobacco

- not registered carrier agents
- unauthorised places/unmanned places
- controlled goods (chewing gums)

**d *Pink Transshipment Declaration***

- containerised cargo from Class II yard

**e *Duty Exemption Certificate***

- Personal effects (supporting documents)
- recycled goods
- non-Mindef military stores
- motor vehicles for embassy/foreign experts
- government import
- duty exemption on racing and golf cars
