All Traders and Declaring Agents

NEW C6 CONDITION FOR PAYMENT PERMITS

1. Traders are presently required to submit a copy of their GST payment permits (including those with C6 condition) and supporting documents to Customs Checkpoint Officers for retention at the time of cargo clearance.
2. With effect from 1 Nov 97, Customs Officers **will not retain** such documents at the Customs Checkpoints. This will prevent congestion and reduce any delay at the Checkpoints.
3. However, you are required to return the permit with the supporting documents to Head Documentation by post within 14 days of Customs clearance, if the permit bears a C6 condition (new). This new condition will be imposed selectively.
4. The new C6 condition is as follows:

You are required to mail a copy of this permit, invoices, freight and insurance papers to Head Documentation at #10-01, 55 Newton Road, Revenue House, Singapore 307987 within 14 days after Customs clearance.
