All Traders, Declaring Agents and Shipping Agents



REMOVAL OF LL PERMIT CONDITION

Currently, the LL permit condition requires shipping agents to submit loadlists via SEA System (Sea Cargo Electronic Acknowledgement System) for dutiable consignments exported via sea, within 7 days of vessel's departure. Similarly, the ground handling agents, namely Singapore Airport Terminal Services (SATS) and Changi International Airport Services (CIAS) are also required to submit the loadlists for exports and transshipment of liquors and cigarettes by air via ACE System (Air Cargo EDI System) within 4 days of the aircraft's departure.

2 Singapore Customs has reviewed the above condition and is pleased to inform you that the above permit condition will be removed with effect from 1 Dec 2003. With this facilitation, the agents will not need to submit loadlists for permits approved after 1 Dec 2003. For permits approved before 1 Dec 2003, loadlists are still required.

3 Please note that Master's Acknowledgement on the receipt of all consignments of liquors and cigarettes transhipped or exported in conventional form by sea (as per current A4 condition), remains unchanged.
