TERMINATION OF ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES IMPOSED ON STEEL REINFORCEMENT BARS AND RODS

Currently, anti-dumping duties are imposed on the import of certain steel reinforcement bars and rods into Singapore from Malaysia and Turkey under the AHTN codes 72142000, 72149921, 72149922 & 72149929. The above duties are due to terminate on 21 Jan 2003.

2 As such, traders importing such goods will no longer be required to take out a Joint Customs/IE Singapore Permit under the declaration type "ID" to pay for the anti-dumping duties with effect from 21 Jan 2003. Instead, traders are required to take up a GST Payment Permit (IG) for such imports. GST is payable and computed based on CIF value of the goods. The documentary control and the procedural requirements on the goods will be the same as those for other GST goods.
