**REMOVAL OF G3 CONDITION**

Currently, the G3 permit condition requires the declaring agents or traders to return the original permits, duly endorsed by the claimants, to Singapore Customs within 4 working days of delivery of goods.

2 Singapore Customs has reviewed the above condition and we are pleased to inform you the above condition will be removed with effect from 1st Jun 2004. Declaring agents no longer need to return such permits to Singapore Customs. For claimants, they are also not required to endorse on the exemption permits. Instead, Singapore Customs will conduct post-audit checks and claimants may be requested to submit returns for the above purpose.
