## MALE SINGAPOREAN ARRESTED AND 2,900 CARTONS OF DUTY-UNPAID CIGARETTES SEIZED IN YISHUN OPERATION

Singapore, 22 December 2023 – In our ongoing efforts to curb illegal cigarette activities, Singapore Customs conducted an operation at a carpark in Yishun Avenue 5 on 20 December 2023.

2 During the operation, our officers saw a man opening the door of a van suspected to contain duty-unpaid cigarettes. They conducted checks and uncovered a total of 2,900 cartons of duty-unpaid cigarettes, which were packed inside brown boxes kept within the van's cargo compartment.

3 Investigations revealed that the man was allegedly engaged by an unknown person to collect and deliver boxes containing duty-unpaid cigarettes. The 31-year-old male Singaporean was arrested, and the duty-unpaid cigarettes seized during the operations.

4 The total duty and Goods and Services Tax (GST) evaded amounted to about \$342,134. Court proceedings are ongoing.

5 Buying, selling, conveying, delivering, storing, keeping, possessing or dealing with duty-unpaid goods are serious offences under the Customs Act and the GST Act. Offenders can be fined up to 40 times the amount of duty, and GST evaded and/or jailed for up to six years.
