# How to declare AEO/STP codes in TradeNet

## Declaration of codes in TradeNet

- Successful first MRA operationalisation on 1 Jan 2011 (with TradeNet® 4.0)
- From 1 Jan 2012 onwards with TradeNet® 4.1
  - ▣ **Customs Processing Code (CPC)** is set aside to recognise AEO shipments
  - ▣ **Processing Codes 1 (PC1)** : Country Code of country that issued the AEO number
  - ▣ **Processing Code 2 (PC2)** : AEO number

## Declaration of codes in TradeNet

Country	CPC	PC1	PC2
 Singapore	AEO	SG	XXXXXXXXXXXX
 Korea	AEO	KR	KRAEOXXXXXXXX
 Japan	AEO	JP	XXXXXXXXXXXX
 China	AEO	CN	XXXXXXXXXXXX

## Domestic Facilitation for STP and STP-Plus Companies

# How to benefit

## Facilitation For STP and STP Plus

- Even without MRAs, Singapore companies who are certified as STP or STP Plus will enjoy **domestic** expedited clearance when exporting from or importing to Singapore
- All STP and STP Plus companies are issued with a unique STP code (17 alphanumeric characters) in the form of **AEOSGXXXXXXXXXXXX**

## Facilitation For STP and STP Plus

- To enjoy benefits, STP and STP Plus companies should ensure that its STP code is accurately declared in their **import/export** TradeNet permit declarations before clearance in Singapore

TradeNet Field	Information to be declared
Customs Procedure Code (CPC)	AEO
Processing Code 1 (PC1)	SG
Processing Code 2 (PC2)	XXXXXXXXXXXX

## Do's on the Use of AEO/STP codes

- DO keep your AEO/STP codes confidential. Only disclose your code to your appointed declaring agents and overseas importers/exporters (with MRAs in place) for permit declaration purposes
- DO check your TradeNet permits periodically to ensure accuracy and correct use of the codes
- DO declare the codes in the correct fields (CPC & PC), and not in CA License or Remarks fields
- DO check with your customers on the accuracy of the codes given and declare the codes accurately in the TradeNet permit declarations (For Declaring Agents)

## Don'ts on the Use of AEO/STP codes

- DO NOT "lend" your AEO/STP code to other companies, even if it is for related companies. STP code is issued based on legal entity.
- DO NOT "retrieve" previous declarations and send without checking (For Declaring Agents)
