GUIDELINES ISSUED FOR 2022



Guidelines on Compliance Checks

Set rules governing the conduct of audit by STMO



Guidelines on Technology Control Plan

Outlines the elements of a TCP compliance system



Guidelines on Non-Strategic Goods Certificate

Provides for means on how covered persons can self-certify that their items are not strategic or NSGC issued by STMO as requested by frontliners



Guidelines on Export Clearance

Outlines the rules for the declaration, clearance and documentation of exports



No Authorization, No Export

Starting 01 January 2023, export of strategic goods without the duly signed authorization from STMO shall not be allowed

STMO GENERAL AUTHORIZATION





GENERAL EXPORT AUTHORIZATION



Authorize the export of certain specified NSGL Annex 2 items to certain specified countries of destination

Two types: Temporary export of strategic goods for repair, maintenance or replacement under warranty or after repair/ replacement.

Each of the General Authorizations contains:

- a **specific list of destinations** to which exports are authorized
- a **specific list of items** that may be exported to those destinations
- a **specific set of conditions of use**, which must be adhered to when exporting

under the particular general authorization

Register with STMO

Verify Coverage

Send Notification to the STMO

Authorization Use



Post Authorization Requirements Recordkeeping, delivery confirmation, among others The STMO General Authorization aims to improve the facilitation of trade of low-risk strategic shipments to low-risk destinations

ENFORCEMENT AND TRADE FACILITATION



- Memorandum of Agreement in Trade Facilitation and Inter-agency Protocols on Enforcement
- Trade Facilitation through the issuance of Non-Strategic Goods Certificate
