STREAMLINED END-USER STATEMENT/CERTIFICATE SUBMISSION

This circular informs you of the streamlined process for submission of enduser statement/certificate (EUS/EUC), with effect from 1 Aug 2023.

- Currently, for goods controlled under the Strategic Goods (Control) Act 2002 (SGCA) <u>and</u> the Chemical Weapons (Prohibition) Act 2000 (CWPA), both an EUS for the Strategic Trade Scheme (STS) Individual Permit and an EUC for the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC) have to be submitted as part of the supporting documents for the application of an export permit. For goods controlled under the SGCA <u>and</u> exported/ transhipped to countries pursuant to United Nations Security Council (UNSC) sanctions or regulations, both an EUS for the STS Individual Permit and an EUC for UNSC countries have to be submitted.
- With the streamlined process from 1 Aug 2023, only a single EUC needs to be submitted. Please refer to the table below for the changes.
