**DOWNTIME FOR ELECTRONIC ORIGIN DATA EXCHANGE SYSTEM (EODES) BETWEEN SINGAPORE AND CHINA**

Singapore Customs will be implementing the Electronic Origin Data Exchange System (EODES) between Singapore and China under the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP). Please be informed that software installation work will be conducted on the EODES Singapore Gateway on the Networked Trade Platform website on the following dates and times.

Date and Time	Duration
10 Dec 2025 8PM to 11 Dec 2025 12AM	4 HR

2 During the abovementioned period, the EODES Singapore Gateway will be shut down and the **EODES service will not be available**. You will not be able to transmit electronic Preferential Certificate of Origin (ePCO) to China's General Administration of Customs (GACC) and your counterparts in China will likewise be unable to transmit ePCO to Singapore Customs. Please transmit your ePCOs before or after the scheduled downtime.

3 Live operation of the EODES Singapore Gateway will resume on **11 Dec 2025**. After resumption, you may electronically transmit the ePCOs under the following **3 Agreements**: ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA), China-Singapore Free Trade Agreement (CSFTA) and RCEP to China's General Administration of Customs (GACC) and your counterparts in China can similarly transmit their ePCOs under the abovementioned 3 Agreements to Singapore Customs.

4 Please look out for our circular on the implementation of electronic transmission of RCEP via EODES to China which will be published once the system is operational.

5 Please bring the contents of this Notice to the attention of your staff. We strongly encourage you to plan and transmit the ePCOs electronically via the EODES before/after the downtime, to minimise disruptions to your business operations. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.
