IMPLEMENTATION OF SELF-DECLARATION SANDBOX FOR TRADERS

We would like to announce the Traders' Self-Declaration Sandbox trial which allows you to declare TradeNet permits for your own goods imported into and/or exported out of Singapore.

Scope of Permit Types Under Self-Declaration Sandbox

2 Under this trial, you can only apply for selected types of import and export permits such as <u>In-Payment GST (IG), In-Non-Payment Approved Premises / Schemes (ME), Out</u> <u>Direct (OD)</u> via TradeNet. You will not be able to declare permits for strategic and dutiable goods (i.e., tobacco and liquor) in TradeNet under the trial. Personal imports and exports made by individuals will not be included in this trial too.

Registration of Interest from Traders

3 The Traders' Self-Declaration trial is only open to all traders whose <u>UEN has been</u> <u>activated with Singapore Customs</u> to import and export goods and <u>are not registered as a</u> <u>Declaring Agent</u> (DA). Under this trial, you will not be required to enrol for and pass the Customs Competency Test for Declarants (SC401). You may register your interest for this initiative by filling up the <u>FormSG</u> via "<u>https://go.gov.sg/traders-self-declaration</u>" by 31 May 2022.
