APPLICATION FOR CUSTOMS INWARD PERMIT FOR NON-DUTIABLE CARGO SHUT-OUT OR RETURNED FROM OVERSEAS

- 1. Under the Goods & Services Tax (Imports Relief) Order 1994, GST relief may be granted to the re-import of non-dutiable goods which were manufactured locally, purchased locally or imported previously. Traders are required to apply for a Customs Inward Permit for their re-import.
- 2. <u>Applications</u> for such permits must be submitted together with the relevant supporting documents to Documentation Branch for processing. To assist traders to submit the correct supporting documents, we have designed the attached format which lists out the documents required for each scenario for use by the traders.
