

Prohibition of Exports to Sierra Leone under UNSC Resolution 1132 (1997)

I&E Notice No. 4/98

To: All Traders, Freight Forwarders,
Cargo Agents and Carriers

We wish to inform you that, in accordance with the UN Resolution 1156 (1998), the prohibition on the export of petroleum and petroleum products to Sierra Leone is lifted with immediate effect.

However, please note that the exportation from Singapore to Sierra Leone of the following items is still prohibited:

- a. arms and related materials of all types including weapons and ammunition, military vehicles and equipment, paramilitary equipment; and
- b. spare parts for the items listed in (a).
