**SALES OF LIQUORS AT LICENSED WAREHOUSES**

Under the Customs Act (Cap70), any person who wants to sell duty-paid liquors by retail or wholesale, has to apply for a liquor licence from the Liquor Licensing Board, Customs Service Centre, 2<sup>nd</sup> level, Revenue House.

2 In this regard, any importer who intends to sell liquors which are stored in a licensed warehouse to another person is required to have such a licence. I would appreciate it if you could inform all your clients who import and store their liquors in your licensed warehouse that they need to apply for a liquor licence for the sale of their liquors by retail or wholesale.
