MARKINGS OF DUTY-EXEMPTED LIQUORS SUPPLIED TO EMBASSIES AND HIGH COMMISSIONS

Currently, duty-exempted liquors supplied to Embassies and High Commissions are required to be marked with the words "Duty Exempted For Diplomatic/Consular Use" on the principal label of the bottle and on the outer carton.

2 We are pleased to inform you that with effect from 15 Oct 2000, the marking requirement would be shortened from "Duty Exempted For Diplomatic/Consular Use" to the letters "DC". The "DC" marking shall be printed or stamped in block letters in indelible ink and the height of each character shall be at least 2 mm for the bottle label and 2 cm for the outer carton. The marking shall be required on all duty-exempted supplies of spirits and wines to Embassies and High Commissions, except beer and stout.
