ISSUE OF DUTY FREE LIQUOR AND TOBACCO FOR CONSUMPTION BY CREW ON BOARD VESSEL

With effect from 1 Jan 2001, there will only be one issue of duty-free rations (liquor and tobacco) for consumption by crew members on board vessel while in Singapore Port. All other excess dutiable stores shall be secured in a lockable store or bond while the vessel is in port.

2 The revised quantity of duty-free liquor and tobacco per bona fide crew member is to be granted as follows:

Present	Revised
Spirits : 1 and 5/8 bottles Or 1.2 litres	Spirits : 1 bottle (not more than 1 litre)
Wines : 7 bottles x 1 litre	Wines : 7 bottles (not more than 7 litres)
Beer & Stout : 14 bottles (28 cans) or 7.92 litres	Beer & Stout : 12 bottles/24 cans (not more than 8 litres)
Tobacco : Cigarettes 280 sticks or cigars 84 sticks or other tobacco 336 grams	Tobacco : Cigarettes 200 sticks or cigars 50 sticks or other tobacco 300 grams
