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ISSUE OF DUTY FREE LIQUOR AND TOBACCO FOR CONSUMPTION BY CREW ON BOARD VESSEL

With effect from 1 Jan 2001, there will only be <u>one issue of duty-free rations</u> (liquor and tobacco) for consumption by crew members on board vessel while in Singapore Port. All other excess dutiable stores shall be secured in a lockable store or bond while the vessel is in port.

2 The revised quantity of duty-free liquor and tobacco per bona fide crew member is to be granted as follows:
