NEW "JI" CODE FOR JURONG ISLAND

Jurong Island was formed in the late 1990s as a result of reclamation of seven islands located off the western tip of Singapore. The road linking the island to the mainland was officially launched on 10 Feb 2000. To transform the island into a world-class chemical manufacturing centre and an integrated Chemical Logistics Hub, the Island has been gazetted as an authorised place for the import, export and transhipment of petroleum and petrochemical products.
