CESSATION OF SEALING OF FLOW-METERS BY CUSTOMS

According to existing procedures, all flow-meters used by oil companies at licensed refineries or installations have to be sealed by the Customs and Excise Department.

In our continuing effort to provide better services to the oil companies, we are pleased to inform you that with immediate effect, all flow-meters in use are not required to be sealed by Customs, subject to the following conditions:-

> Oil companies are to ensure that all flow-meters are affixed with Weights and Measures Office's (WMO) seal(s) and shall report to Customs immediately if any such seal is broken or tampered with;

> Oil companies are to register all flow-meters in use with Customs and to promptly inform Customs of any changes;

> Oil companies are to ensure that the quantity of petroleum product released through the flow-meter totaliser is accounted for in their monthly report;

> Oil companies are to inform Customs to immediately seal the valves of flowmeters that are jammed or out of order;

> Customs shall be informed as soon as the flow-meter is ready for use again after servicing, repair or re-calibration by the authorised organisations and re-sealed by WMO; and

> Oil companies are to submit a monthly report of daily records on the opening and closing meter readings (totaliser) to Petroleum Section, Controls Branch, Customs and Excise Department by e-mail.
