LIFTING OF PROHIBITION ON IMPORTS & EXPORTS TO ANGOLA

Further to our I&E Notice No. 14/98, dated 5 Aug 1998, we wish to inform you that the prohibition of the following imports to and exports from Angola is lifted with immediate effect:

Imports

a. direct or indirect import of diamonds and diamond-related products (eg, diamond jewellery) of Angolan origin

Exports

- a. petroleum;
- b. petroleum products;
- c. any arms and related materials (including weapons and ammunitions, military vehicles, military equipment and paramilitary equipment);
- d. any component for any goods specified in (c);
- e. any goods specially designed or prepared for use, or normally used in the manufacture or maintenance of any goods specified in (c) or (d);
- f. aircraft or aircraft components;
- g. equipment used in mining or mining services;
- h. motorized vehicles or watercraft; and
- i. spare parts for motorized vehicles or watercraft.
