All Traders And Declaring Agents

LIFTING OF PROHIBITION ON IMPORTS & EXPORTS TO IRAQ

We wish to inform you that, in accordance with the UN Security Council Resolution 1483 (2003), all trade sanctions against Iraq have been lifted with immediate effect with the exception to the sale and /or supply of:

- a) arms and related materials of all types, including-
 - i) weapons;
 - ii) ammunition;
 - iii) military vehicles;
 - iv) military equipment; and
 - v) paramilitary equipment; and
 - b) spare parts of any item falling under paragraph (a).
- 2 Other than the above items, traders can submit permit applications for their imports and exports relating to Iraq through TradeNet for processing.
- 3 TradeNet Users are reminded to update the existing prompting message in your front-end software by amending the “**THIRD**” Schedule to the “**FOURTH**” Schedule as follows:
- P01 WARNING - YOUR APPLICATION MAY BE WITHIN THE AMBIT OF THE **FOURTH** SCHEDULE OF THE REGULATION OF IMPORTS AND EXPORTS REGULATIONS (Rg 1) [s530/95]. PLEASE REFER TO IT BEFORE PROCEEDING ANY FURTHER.**
