## REMOVAL OF PRE-SHIPMENT TRADENET PERMIT DECLARATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN EXPORTS/RE-EXPORTS TO THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND IRAN

Further to our Customs Circular No. 28/2003 dated 13 Aug 2003, traders that export or re-export items listed in Annex A of the Circular to Iran or the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) no longer need to submit a Jnt3 (or "XO") permit for the shipment. You may submit a normal export declaration for such items through TradeNet.

## Clarification on Tradenet Permit Declaration Requirements for Imports From and Exports To Iran and DPRK

- Further to our Custom Customs Circular No. 22/2006 dated 28 Dec 2006 and 06/2007, with effect from 0001 hrs on 15 Jun 2007, traders who import, export or re-export **non-prohibited goods** from/to Iran or the DPRK, **except strategic goods**, are no longer required to submit the TradeNet permit declarations at least 3 working days before the date of shipment. For exports of strategic goods to these destinations, you are still required to submit a Jnt3 permit declaration.
