**CHANGES IN CLEARANCE PROCEDURES AND DECLARATION OF CODES**

For permits approved from **20 May 2008**, please note the following changes in the clearance procedure for cargo released from or received into an unmanned place where there is no ICA presence. Instead of presenting these goods for clearance at the nearest checkpoints which are manned by ICA, you are required to comply with the respective condition(s) in your Cargo Clearance Permit (CCP):

<b>CB</b>	THE GOODS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THIS PERMIT AT THE TIME OF REMOVAL	This is a reminder that for goods released from or received into unmanned places, it must be accompanied by the correct permit at all times.

**Place of Release and Receipt Codes for TradeNet®-declarations**

2 In addition, the following location codes should not be declared as the Places of Release *and/or* Receipt. For cargo clearance purposes, please declare the nearest FTZ as indicated below:

3 However, the above location codes for the wharves are still valid vessel location codes. You may therefore continue to declare these codes in the Inward or Outward Vessel Location Code fields in your permit application covering sea shipments.
