TEMPORARY IMPORT OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR REPAIRS

Under the Temporary Import Scheme, motor vehicles are allowed to be temporarily imported for repairs without payment of duty and/or GST. The conditions of the Scheme include that they be re-exported within three months from the date of importation.

- 2 The current procedure requires the declarant to apply for a Customs In-Non-Payment (Temporary Consignment for repair) permit under the Temporary Import Scheme at the time of importation.
- 3 From 1 Jun 2009, please attach declarations from the importer and the workshop when you submit your permit declaration. Please fax the documents to fax no: 6250 9605. To avoid any delay in the processing of your application, do ensure that the declarations are completed and correct.
