UPDATE TO THE STRATEGIC GOODS CONTROL LIST

In line with Singapore's commitment to our international obligations to prevent the proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD), Singapore Customs regularly updates our strategic goods control list to be in line with international practices.

2 At present, you may be referring to the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2010 and the Strategic Goods (Control) Amendment Order 2011 for the list of controlled strategic goods. Please note that both Orders will be rescinded and replaced with a new Order 2012. This new Order will take effect in January 2013.

3 The Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2012 will incorporate revisions adopted by the four multilateral export control regimes. These revisions include new entries, some deletions, as well as editorial changes for consistency and clarity of controls.

4 The table below provides a comparison of the Strategic Goods (Control) Order 2012 against the lists of the four multilateral export control regimes.
