

IMPLEMENTATION OF ELECTRONIC AMENDMENT AND DEFERRED PRINTING OPTIONS FOR CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN (CO) FROM 1 APRIL 2013

Advance Export Declaration (AED) will be implemented from 1 April 2013. SC will require <u>ALL</u> declarations to be submitted <u>before</u> the goods are exported.

Amendment of Certificate of Origin

- In conjunction with the AED implementation, we are pleased to inform that you can also submit amendments via TradeNet® to update the previously approved Export Permit with CO applications. The electronic amendments can be for both Permit and CO details provided that it is done within permit's validity period. In particular, information on the CO that can be allowed for electronic amendments are:
 - i. Exporter's/Consignee's name and address;
 - ii. Country of origin and/or destination;
 - iii. Port of discharge
 - iv. Date of departure;
 - v. Marks and numbers;
 - vi. Certificate description of goods;
 - vii. Origin criteria text;
 - viii. Certificate quantity and FOB details; and
 - ix. Invoice details

Certificate Printing Option

3 Currently, the printed CO is ready for collection 2 working hours after its approval. To better facilitate electronic CO amendments, we have provided a new option for you to defer the printing of CO to a later date. The options available are:

i. Immediate Printing (default) - Current Option

This printing option is as per current practice where your CO will be ready for collection about 2 working hours after its approval. (Amendments submitted after CO approval will incur extra cost due to printing of re-issued CO.)

ii. Deferred Printing (add 2 working days) – New Option

This printing option enables you to request for delayed printing of your CO. The deferred printing option will allow you to have sufficient time to make amendments to the CO fields prior to the printing. You can submit your amendments via TradeNet® any time before the CO is generated for printing hence save costs on re-printing of CO. (The CO will be generated for printing on Day 3, hence the cut-off time for electronic amendments is 00:00:00 hours of Day 3. Amendments submitted after the cut-off time will incur extra cost due to printing of re-issued CO.)

To activate this deferred printing option, you must select "Deferred Printing for CO" from the Customs Procedure Code (CPC) field in your TradeNet® Frontend Solution. Once the information is entered the CO will be printed on the 2nd working day from its approval date. For example, if the CO is approved on Day 1, the CO will be ready for collection in the morning of Day 3.

New Approval Condition Code

4 With electronic CO amendment and deferred CO printing options, 2 new approval Condition Codes will apply:
