REMOVAL OF SHUT-OUT GOODS FROM FREE TRADE ZONE (FTZ)

This circular sets out the documentation requirements for removal of shut-out goods from the Free Trade Zones (FTZs) under the following scenarios:

- a) Goods removed <u>within 24 hours</u> from the entry of goods into a FTZ, where the goods were <u>not</u> previously released from a Licensed Warehouse/Zero GST Warehouse, <u>not</u> previously imported under Temporary Import Scheme or <u>not</u> under transhipment with inter-gateway movement:
 - i) Re-import of non-dutiable goods into customs territory Customs permit not required
 - ii) Re-import of dutiable goods into customs territory In-Payment (Duty and GST) permit
- b) Goods removed <u>after 24 hours</u> from the entry of goods into a FTZ, where the goods were <u>not</u> previously released from a Licensed Warehouse/Zero GST Warehouse, <u>not</u> previously imported under Temporary Import Scheme or <u>not</u> under transhipment with inter-gateway movement:
 - i) Re-import of non-dutiable goods into customs territory In-Non-Payment (Shut-out) permit
 - ii) Re-import of dutiable goods into customs territory In-Payment (Duty and GST) permit
- c) Goods that were previously released from a Licensed Warehouse/Zero GST Warehouse:
 - Re-import of non-dutiable and/or dutiable goods into Licensed Warehouse Scheme/Zero GST Warehouse Scheme - In-Non-Payment (Shut-out) permit
 - ii) Re-import of non-dutiable and/or dutiable goods into customs territory In-Payment (GST)/In-Payment (Duty and GST) permit

- d) Goods that were previously imported under Temporary Import Scheme: Re-import of non-dutiable and/or dutiable goods into customs territory
 - In-Payment (GST)/In-Payment (Duty and GST) permit
- e) Goods that were previously under transhipment with inter-gateway movement (i.e. transhipment from first checkpoint to second checkpoint, and shut-out from second checkpoint):
 - i) Import of non-dutiable and/or dutiable goods into Licensed Warehouse Scheme/Zero GST Warehouse Scheme - In-Non-Payment (Approved Premises/Schemes) permit
 - ii) Import of non-dutiable and/or dutiable goods into customs territory In-Payment (GST)/In-Payment (Duty and GST) permit

2 The detailed documentation requirements, including the supporting documents to be produced to ICA officer for inward cargo clearance of the shut-out goods for the above five scenarios are in the attached **Annex A**.

3 We would like to remind traders that local goods that are not meant for export should not be brought into the FTZs, as the FTZs are meant to facilitate entrepot trade and transhipment activities.

4 This Circular supersedes previous Customs Circulars (No. 37/1997, 04/2001 and 09/2001) issued on this matter.
